
Installation Instructions





- 2. Locate the plug on the end of the trap. To make suce the powder does not splft upon opening, hold the trap Plug End Up and tap the other and a few times on a hard surface to settle the powder. Next, hold the trap horizontal (base down / scaled openings up) and shake it side to side a few times, then tap the base on a hard surface to settle the powder across the bottom.
- 3. Continuing to keep the trap horizontal from this point on: Without squeezing the trap Gently peel off the white tape strips scaling the triangular openings on the back of the frap. Once open, do not blow on, tip or shake the trap as you may spill the powder. Carefully peel the pink backing from the narrow adhesive strips on either side of the trap to expose the adhesive. Be careful not to touch or soil the adhesive pads or your trap might not stick properly.
- 4. Keeping the trap horizontal, take it to the upper right corner of the affected window, and (without letting it touch the glass) position it straight & LEVEL, leaving a finger width gap between the trap and the top and right-side window frame, while leaving at least 6" of clearance on the left side of the trap to allow the Lure Tube to be removed. Firmly press each end of the trap against the glass and pull the bottom gently to assure it is well stuck. Check adhesion periodically.
- 5. Activate Lure: Remove the Plug on the left-side of the trap by carefully pulling it straight out along with the PheroGel™ Lure Tube. Place the Lure Tube in a small glass filled half way with water for 30 minutes to hydrate the lure. Remove it from the water and left it stop dripping, then carefully re-insert it into the trap. You can re-hydrate the lure once a week during busy bug season, or whenever it becomes needed. The lure smalls good but it's not for human consumption.



LADYBUG BUSTER

Your new Ladybug Buster' system from Powder Trap' works by installing one trap in each window that has ladybugs. A complete system with one trap in each problem window forms a long term solution lasting up to 2 years or more. Within several days of applying your traps to the windows you will see a decline in the number of ladybugs as they cautiously explore the new device. It's normal behaviour for ladybugs to cluster around and behind the trap for extended periods before entering from above or behind. Please have patience, the traps will work! If the lady bugs are cold or have recently fed they will be less inclined to explore. Removing any nearby sources of food or water will increase the effectiveness of your new trap. Your new Ladybug Buster' is the best, safest and least costly long-term solution available.
